Short story of our garden

The name of the Garden is derived from Tai Language – the meaning of which is “Dancing Tortoise”. The significance of which is – that in those days Towkok river was full of dancing tortoises and also the first plantation of Towkok was done on the bank of Towkok river in Section No. N-2 in the year 1885, which is now uprooted and replanted during the year 1991-92 as Section No. 2 of Old Line Division with latest clones.



Features

The Garden is situated in the foothills of Nagaland and surrounded by Government reserve forest and has variety of wild life, when taken-over, roaming freely and at times creating endanger to human life. At the time of takeover, out of a total grant area of 3132.20 hectare only 500.24 hectare was under tea leaving a sizeable area under dense forest for future expansion.

With the fast rate extension and replantation, the property went on increasing in size and shape day by day and warranted decentralization and creation of different estates in the year 1970, which are Towkok Tea Estate (845.66 Hectares), Manjushree Tea Estate (403.38 Hectares), Mangalam Tea Estate (117.99 Hectares).
